Parents must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- having an unavoidable medical or dental appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to

Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record. 


Yellow H News
